 - available to download from our website






2024 Estimated Year End Total Expenses



Advertising Activity Highlights

- This year, we did something NEW!
- Churches in the Chicago Metro area were sponsoring
 11 CS Lectures last spring
 - New opportunity to create combined ad for a "spring lecture series"
- We used media in new ways to reach more seekers
 - Sunday print edition of the Chicago Tribune
 - Email access to *Tribune* subscribers living within 7 miles of each of the lecture venues
- Results were terrific:
 - Print ads reached 800,000 subscribers on 9 Sundays
 - Series of 10 emails reached 325,000 subscribers total, driving traffic to our website
 - 9,500 recipients clicked to learn more, contributing to increase of time on site of each 1 min/avg

Advertising Activity Highlights

- Advertising on Google proved very effective this year
 - Three ads ran throughout year promoting
 - 1. Reading Rooms
 - 2. Wednesday Meetings
 - 3. Science and Health

Results:

- Over 1.8 million views year to-date, resulting in 28.5K clicks to our website to learn more
- · Overall, we are on track to meet or exceed our goals
 - 2,800,000 impressions (views) of advertising on Google, Meta social media platforms and the Chicago Tribune
 - · Achieve over 47,000 clicks from ads to visit our website
 - Reach 500 followers on Facebook and 450 on Instagram

Advertising - Looking ahead

- Celebrate Science and Health's 150th year anniversary in 2025 through advertising and promotion messages throughout the entire year
- Expand relationship with Chicago Tribune to include joint promotions on Meta social media platforms
- Overall, increase targeted impressions from 2,800,000 to 3,000,000 in 2025

Website Activity Highlights

- Once again most website activity ever!
 - On track to achieve 38K visitors by December
 - 12K more than last year
 - On track to achieve ~54K page views by year end
 - 46% over goal
- Website visitors are finding local resources effectively, staying on website for an average of 1 minute/visit vs 40 seconds/visit last year





Website - Looking ahead

- Goal: Continue updates based on performance to keep things fresh and current
 - Over the past 5 years, there have been 3 major revisions
- Ensure visitors can continue to navigate website with ease, visiting multiple areas before exiting
 - path often begins on RR page > Healings landing page and opens one of nine testimonies in collection > the Weds Mtg or Events pages before exiting site
- The Key: Always looking at trends to help seekers connect in most meaningful way
 - e.g. "Centers for Spiritual Living" is a great descriptor for RRs
 - "Spiritual well being" connects with today's spiritual seekers
 - Terms like "prayer groups" and "prayer circles" helps make connections to Wednesday Meetings

2024 Helpline Activity

Telephone Helpline

The "Helpline" at 630-929-5635 provides Weekly Bible Lessons, Sentinel Watch, and Daily Lift podcasts.

There is no charge for the service.

Callers can leave a message requesting help, expressing gratitude, or reporting a healing.

Helpline Activity Highlights

- 12 reported healings (Jan-Aug) received on the helpline (19 total in 2023)
- An average of 433 unique callers per month (423 in 2023; 419 in 2022)
- 180 recorded messages and 18 direct calls
- The time to record a message has been increased from 1 to 3 minutes (no added expense)
- Helpline is shared with Washington State Media Committee
- Working group members dedicate time daily to pray in support of this healing practice

Helpline Activity Highlights

- Callers express deep appreciation of the helpline
 - Often do not live near a church or are unable to get a church service or RR
 - Healings and spiritual growth are a natural result of listening to the programming



Expo Activity Highlights

Dozens of meaningful conversation with fellow seekers

- A woman stopped by and said, "I attended a concert at the Christian Science Church in downtown Chicago (17th Church of Christ, Scientist) where I saw something about Mary Baker Eddy. Now I see she wrote a book." The visitor carefully read the back cover of the book and talked with the booth worker and decided to purchase the book.
- A mother and her two teenage daughters listened while the booth attendant shared how she had found Science and Health so helpful in raising her own children and learning how the ideas in the book helped them to see their genuine identity. The mom decided to purchase the book.
- A lovely lady related over the years she had experienced several car accidents. She said she found help in turning to God. She persisted in continuing to go to work and got her educational degree despite the challenges. I shared how the ideas in *Science* and *Health* bring healing. She bought the book.
